Health Check- up camp by DOE was also held to increase health awareness amongst the children.

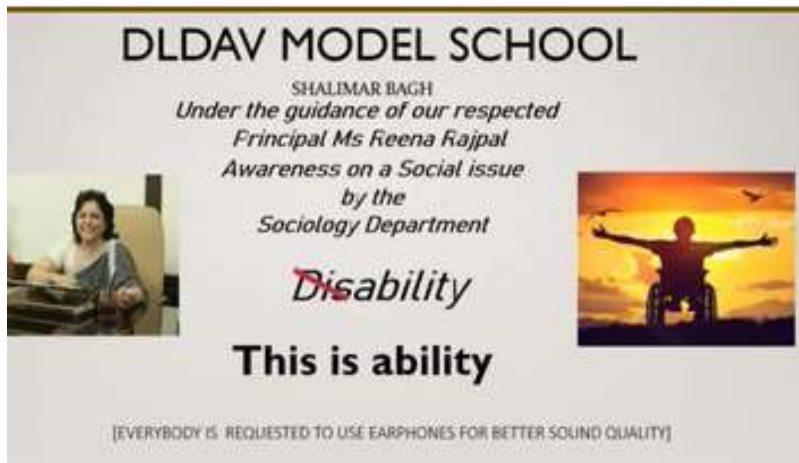

We have also joined hands with Helen O' Grady International in which the communication skills are enhanced through the medium of Drama



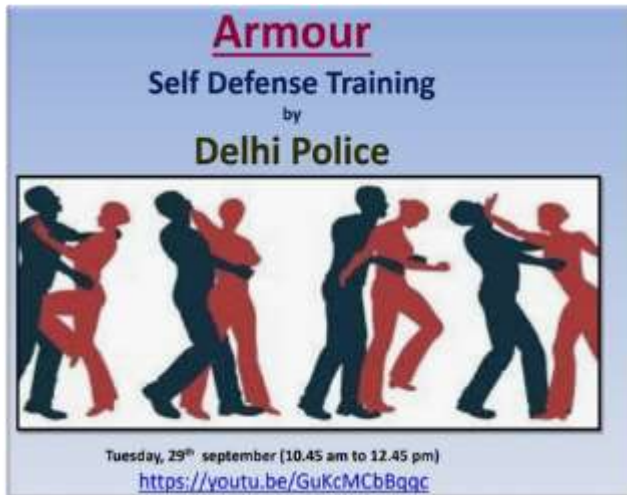

Students were given Holidays Home Work Projects on theme 'Clean Earth' which were then put on display during PTMs

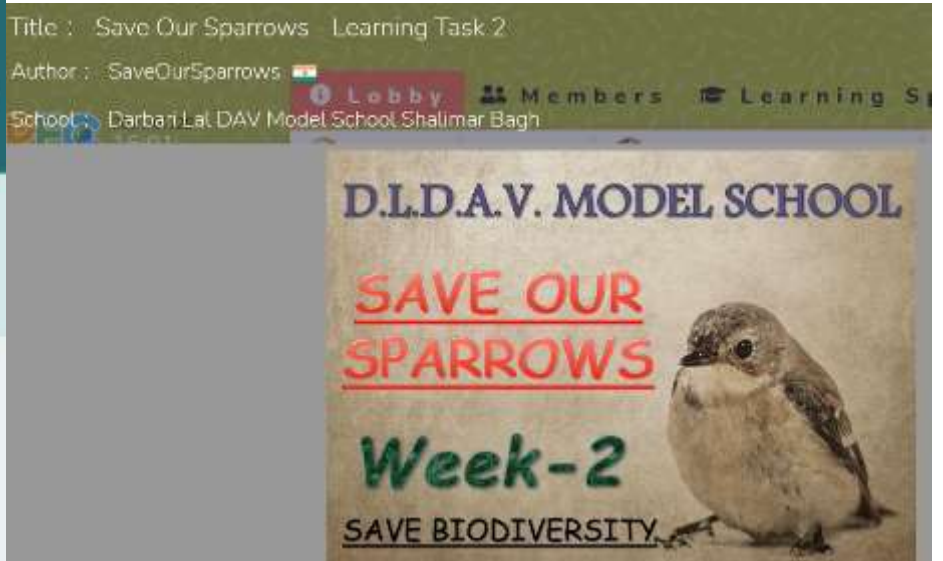

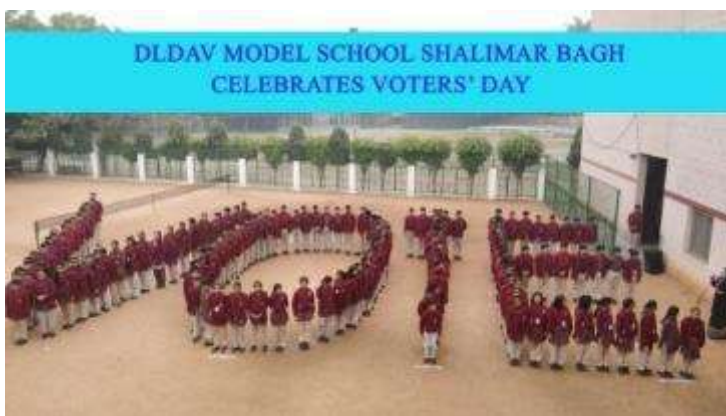

We joined hands with Helpmekaar College, South Africa to play friendly cricket matches



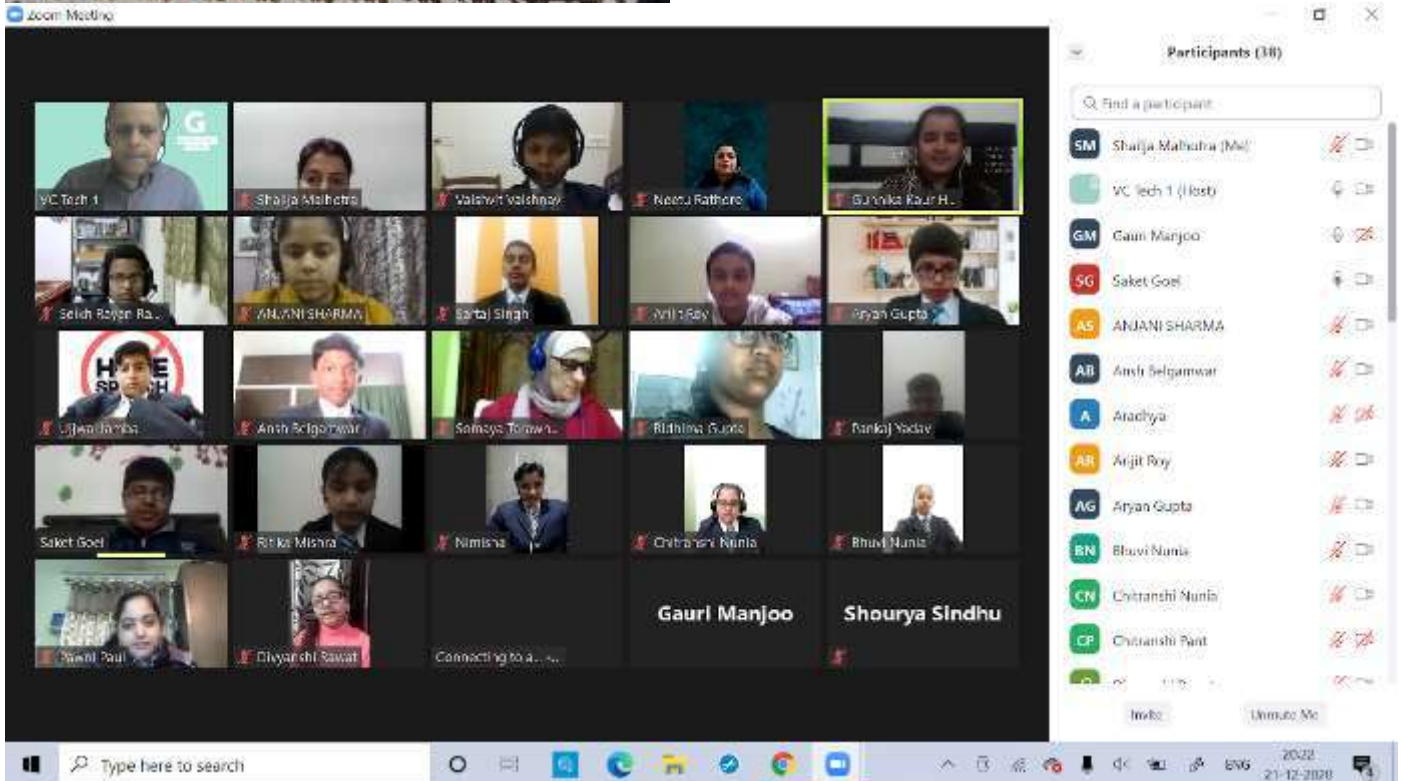
