This fantastic achievement makes us incredibly proud of our students. Through the dedication and hard work, our business team has not only developed valuable entrepreneurial and life skills but has also generated real profit!

Our journey as teen tycoons began with a **shared dream: to build a sustainable business that made a positive difference**. What followed was a story of creativity, inclusivity, and collaboration.

A **dynamic team of students (Grades 7–11), and teachers from multiple disciplines came together to launch our school enterprise**. Divided into three departments—Production, Quality Control, and Marketing & Accounts—we rotated roles monthly, gaining hands-on experience through shadowing sessions and training manuals. To raise capital, we **hosted a Fun Fiesta for primary students** and held a pre-sales event that saw enthusiastic support from teachers. Combined with reinvestments from our previous venture *Srijan*, we were ready to launch.

Our **eco-friendly products—Rakhis, keychains, and Diwali décor**—were made from recycled materials collected from students and staff. Challenges like material shortages sparked innovation: we sourced embellishments from wholesale markets and repurposed unsold items into torans and wall hangings.

Inclusivity was a core value. Products created by special needs students and NGOs were proudly showcased, adding depth and purpose to our range.





We promoted our venture through **e-flyers, WhatsApp, PA announcements, and classroom visits—reaching over 8,000 families**. At our PTM launch, customers were named **“Eco Champs”** and received badges for supporting sustainability. Real-world learning came through **role rotations, accounting challenges, and adapting to customer needs**. We **offered discounts, festive combos, and surprise gifts** to boost engagement, with guidance from local shopkeepers on customer etiquette. The impact was real—we **earned profits, learned leadership, problem-solving, and built lasting confidence**. We **donated 10% of our profits to old-age homes and blind schools, reinforcing our commitment to community welfare**. Looking ahead, we plan to **expand into millet-based bakery goods, upcycled furniture, and even 3D-printed products**. With mentorship in place, the next team is ready to carry the vision forward. This experience transformed us—not just as **young entrepreneurs, but as eco-conscious, compassionate individuals**.




Solar outdoor air purifier and air quality monitor.

GAME ON: BUILDING STRENGTH THROUGH SPORTS

FUELING FITNESS, FOSTERING CHAMPIONS

As outlined in the CBSE Health and Physical Education (HPE) Manual, sports and physical activities play a vital role in promoting both mental and physical development. The manual emphasizes that "sports are capable of developing team spirit, mental toughness, and physical strength among students."

Aligned with these principles and bolstered by strong parental support, the school remains committed to fostering holistic development and nurturing future athletes who can excel at national and international levels.

Starting from the academic session 2025–26, the school will place greater emphasis on sports, aiming to spark students' interest and help them discover their aptitudes. In addition to the regular weekly games period for Classes III–X, two dedicated sports sessions have been added to the timetable. These sessions will be conducted under the guidance of professionally appointed coaches, maintaining a healthy teacher-student ratio of 1:20 or 1:25 to ensure personalized attention and meaningful outcomes.
