He was selected by Roller Skating Federation of India to represent India in the World Skate Games held in Buenos Aires and Argentina. IN the 19TH ASIAN ROLLER SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP HELD In China, Krish was amongst the top four in the 3000 metre RELAY RACE. In the 61st National Championship at Chennai, he bagged three gold and two silver medals.

Krish Sharma delivered remarkable results at the 51st Delhi State Skating Championship, securing 1st place in multiple events.

Our school ranks amongst the top 10 in North Zone by the Times school survey.





CBSE BOARD RESULT HIGHLIGHTS 2023-24



A total of 251 students appeared for the Class XII Board exams out of which 84 students secured distinction in all the subjects. Some students have secured cent percent in different subjects.

Vedant Jain is our school topper. He obtained a scintillating 96% and topped the Science stream. He also got the highest PCM- 96.7%



A total of 309 students appeared for the Class X exam and 362 A1 grades were obtained in various subjects. 68 students secured 90% and above and a total of 1806 distinctions were obtained in various subjects. 145 students got distinctions in all the subjects and the QPI was an excellent 80.27. Pushpit Chhabra -our school topper- made us proud by getting 97.8 %
